#### STEM Week Making Learning Fun

The IT & STEM Club organised the STEM Week, which lasted from 18<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019. Many activities aiming at promoting STEM knowledge were available to students, including a 3D printing workshop, a Micro:Bit workshop and a STEM Quiz.

In the 3D printing workshop, students learnt how to use the online website Tinkercad to create and design their favourite 3D models as key holders. Then the club committee members helped the participants print their 3D models using the 3D printer. Another activity that attracted many participants was the Micro:Bit workshop, in which video game enthusiasts designed a simple shooting game using their knowledge of coding and engineering.
