Hoi Ping Scholars Make History in HKDSE 2020

Hoi Ping students' diligence and resilience during school suspension enabled them to bring home the most impressive results since the start of the HKDSE.

The percentage of students attaining levels 5+ and 4+ leapt to a record high of 30.9% and 71.7% respectively; 3.3% of students attained Level 5**, our second-best performance since 2012. Of the 150 S6 students, 88% of them attained the university entrance minimum requirement (33222), which is also our second-best performance.

The percentage of students scoring 22 points or above in their Best 5 subjects was 41.3%, with a rise of 8.4%. In particular, an impressive 40% of our students captured 5* or 5** in Mathematics Module 2 (M2); as for English Language, the percentage of students capturing 5** jumped to 4%. The elective subject with the best performance was Economics, with 10% and 21.7% of students attaining levels 5** and 5* respectively.

We send our heartfelt congratulations to our S6 students, and hope this encouraging trend will continue!

into learning effectively.




Budding Architects Plugged Into the Realm of Architecture!


